Explanatory notes for the completion of the Xantic Application for: Inmarsat C - Datareporting & Polling service

Service Descriptions

- **Inmarsat-C Data Reporting and Polling**

Allows fast and cost effective transmission of small data packets from mobile terminals. Data may originate from sensors or other hardware devices connected to the mobile terminal. Polling allows for the broadcast of signals with or without text from one fixed location to one or more terminals.

- **Inmarsat-C Communication and messaging via two-stage-access**

Registration for Inmarsat-C Datareporting & Polling will also automatically authorize you to send ordinary messages via the terrestrial network and through Xantic, to mobile C-terminals in the AOR-E, AOR-W, IOR and POR. Inmarsat-C communication is on a store and forward basis. Inmarsat-C charges are per 256 bits. The Two-stage Access registration is free of charge (no charges for Username and Password).

- **Inmarsat-C Communication and messaging via e-mail**

Registration of your e-mail address for Inmarsat-C Datareporting & Polling will also automatically authorize you to use the C-email SAT.400 service to send ordinary messages via the Internet through Xantic, to mobile C-terminals in the AOR-E , AOR-W , IOR and POR. Inmarsat-C charges are per 256 bits.

- **Payment**

The Data Reporting & Polling services require a direct billing relationship with Xantic B.V. For new customers, Xantic reserves the right to perform a preliminary financial check.

Xantic charges no administrative handling fees. Each month the registered customer will receive a specified bill. Following the approval of the application the registered customer will receive a *USERNAME* and *PASSWORD* for messaging and Polling services which will identify the registered user as an officially registered member with Xantic. Customers will only have access to those services for which they are registered.

For Data Reporting and Polling Services the customer will receive a monthly invoice from Xantic.

- **Datareporting & Polling registration**

A Data Network ID (DNID) or closed user group number is necessary for use of Data Reporting and Polling services.

Each DNID is connected to one terrestrial address. Data reports from all mobile terminals using this DNID will be routed to this address. Data reports can be either delivered immediately to the destination, or kept in a DNID-file (except for e-mail delivery).

Possible choices are:

Immediate delivery via:

PSTN:	The international/national telephone network. All data reports will be routed to a telephone number. Xantic will deliver the data reports to your application via a voice-band modem.
FAX:	Data reports will be converted to FAX format and routed to a FAX number.
PSDN:	The international/national X.25 network.
Telex:	Data reports will be delivered by telex.
E-mail:	Datareports will be delivered via e-mail.

Delivery to DNID file/mailbox:

Data reports will be collected and stored in the DNID file at the LES. The DNID file can be retrieved by the user or forwarded to its destination at pre-defined intervals.

- **Datareporting & Polling registration charges**

No registration fees apply to this service. No periodical subscription fee is charged. No charges apply to the issue of Usernames and Passwords.

Charges for data reporting are per report and depend on the size of the report. Charges for polling are per 256 bits and per ocean region, expressed in US dollars (USD). Australian customers will be billed in Australian dollars (AUD).

Subject: Vessel Monitoring System (VMS) in Greenland.

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Greenland Fisheries License Control Authority (GFLK) operates a Vessel Monitoring System in order to keep at track on all foreign fishing vessels as well as domestic vessels above 90 BT operating inside the Greenland EEZ. The Greenland Command (GLK) has access to the VMS and uses it when they in force the sovereignty of the EEZ and carry out fishery patrol. Further, they use the VMS-information during SAR-operations.

The VMS system is based on two types of transmitters installed on board the vessels. Deep-sea fishing vessels operating outside the base line is equipped with an Inmarsat-C, which via a DNID (Data Network ID) and the LES Station12 forward hourly position reports to GFLK Fisheries Monitoring Center (FMC). Smaller coastal vessels mainly operating inside the base line are equipped with an ARGOS unit, which through the LES in Toulouse forward hourly reports to the same FMC.

Whereas, GLK and the Bureau of Minerals and Petroleum need to keep a track of the seismic vessels in the Greenland EEZ seismic vessels should report hourly positions to the FMC. This will enable the Bureau of Minerals and Petroleum effectively to sort out any conflict between the seismic activities and the fishery if fishermen claim compensation for loss of catch or indemnity for damaged gear.

GFLK applies a set of provisions on secure and confidential treatment of the position reports received in the VMS. No position reports can be made available to other than GFLK, GLK and the Bureau of Minerals and Petroleum.

Seismic vessels equipped with a Inmarsat-C transceiver, preferably a Thrane & Thrane, should arrange for the download of a DNID to the terminal and have the terminal programmed to forward position reports including course and speed every hour. The DNID should be downloaded before arriving the Greenland EEZ and duly tested before the seismic operations commence. Seismic vessels with an approved LRIT installation may use this system to report their position to GFLK.

If the seismic vessel prefers, it can be arranged that the vessel lease an ARGOS unit at O.S.Electronic ApS in Nuuk. The unit can be installed in Nuuk at arrival and removed when the vessel leave Greenland waters.

Annexed to this note is an application form for the download of DNID (Application for Inmarsat-C DATA REPORTING and POLLING) page 2 has been filled in by GFLK.
