Re: Request for information and documents on a bill banning uranium exploration and mining

Dear Ladies and gentlemen,

As we have been informed by the Nuna Law Company, the Ministry of Mineral Resources has sent a draft amendment to some Mineral Exploration License holders to ban uranium exploration and mining and to allow the Greenland Government to gradually add further restrictions and bans on geological activities in Greenland.

We have consulted on this matter with our lawyers.


While we understand the new government's motivation to protect the population and nature from the possible negative effects of industrial activity, we believe that the proposal may induce a number of questions and doubts about the future investments in Greenland.

We request that our company, as the holder of two exclusive mineral licenses, be officially informed about the intention of the Greenland Government to fundamentally change the conditions for the exploration of minerals.

We request to be provided with all documents and information concerning the change of the law in an official manner from an authorized representative of the Ministry.

We ask to be formally invited to the consultation process on the new law draft and to be given a reasonable period of time to familiarize ourselves with the text of the proposed law and to comment on this draft.
